- 5. No motor homes or trailers attached to booths will be allowed.
- 6. Each exhibitor is responsible for collection and disposal of booth trash.
- 7. Vendors must park their vehicle in designated <u>Vendor Parking Area</u>. This will be strictly enforced—if in violation, vehicle will be towed.
- 8. The booth fee for one food booth of \$195.00 is non-refundable. If your application and fees are received by November 21, 2014 the booth fee will be \$175! Remember booth space is limited and is awarded on a first come first serve basis.
